

A.C.T KANGAROO CULL SITE WATCH GUIDE

WHY DO WE WATCH SITES

- To gain an understanding of the rangers activity and movements
- To help dictate future action
- To send a message to the government that we are watching
- To document anything we can

WHAT TO DO

- Drive past the sites and look for any activities (entrances will usually have "warning" signs)
- Sit outside of sites and keep watch

WHAT TO BRING

- Lights (torch and headlamp)
- Camera
- Something to read
- Gloves and other warm clothing
- Doona or blanket (it gets cold sitting still) hot water bottle
- Water/munchies
- Mobile phone - record shooting, if it is happening and you can hear it easily on phone

THINGS TO REPORT;

- Is there shooting
- Are there cars (how many cars, licence plates, anything unique about them)
- Are there people (are they rangers, are the shooters, police?)
- The time and location you saw them
- If you have come more than once ask yourself if it looks and or feels different to last time

We will collate all of this information, anything noteworthy is valuable.

RESERVE SIGNS

Look for signs like this to determine you are in the right location.



WHAT TO DO IF YOU HEAR SHOOTING

- Get in touch with others to help out
- Wait until someone else gets there
- While watching observe - eyes and ears
- Report when others turn up
- Record video with phone
- Determine if you would like to interfere

DIRECT ACTION TACTICS

- Enter site and disrupt shooting
- Use noisy things - pots, whistles etc (old ones so if you have to throw them away if/when police turn up you can), air horns

OFFENCES, PENALTIES, RANGERS' POWERS

POLICE

They will make things up - they only have move on powers (e.g sometimes they will tell you that you can't park on the side of the road but you can of course)
